Chief Updates

Police Chief Allen reports that crime is up as attributed to the Covid-19 pandemic; including, but not limited to Domestic Assaults, Child Neglect, Simple Assaults, drug and alcohol related infraction and drunk driving. The department will continue to work together to provide protection and keep community safe. Encouraging news was Covert, despite the increase is still lower than our neighboring communities.

Fire Chief Jed Wild presented detailed report on the trainings and working closely with the health Department to ensure that the Firefighters are able to accurately assist with administrating the vaccine. The department is in full swing with daily shift trainings; Two additional part time workers complete the department as being fully staffed; Information will be forthcoming concerning when vaccinating will be available to the community at the Covert Fire Departments Location.
