## **New Business**

- The process to schedule and fund the maintenance and repair of primary roads was discussed. This included the scheduled sealcoating of Blue Star Highway and possible resurfacing and/or widening of CR 376. A lengthy discussion was had on how the County prioritizes and funds projects, as well as how to improve communications to board members.
- The process to schedule and fund the maintenance and repair of local roads was discussed. The 2019 schedule was presented.
- CR 376 was discussed. The VB Road Commission is exploring several options to upgrade CR 376, from sealcoating to crushing, reshaping and resurfacing. If the latter is chosen, it will need to be widened to bring it up to standard.

- The ditching schedule for 2019 was presented. The depth of the ditching and whether blockages can affect neighboring cross pipes and culverts was discussed.
- The boom mowing schedule for 2019 was explained. Concerns regarding blind corners and timing of mowing was addressed.
- Status on cross-pipe replacements was presented.
- Process to repair and replace driveway culverts was discussed. K. Harrington asked the County and Board to consider ways of alleviating the burden on residents who are required to replace their driveway culvert. D. Cook asked how we can better educate the public on their options.
- A discussion ensued on how to improve communication and get more information on open and resolved tickets with the Road Commission and Township. L. Taylor asked the Road Commission on their overall opinion of Covert Township's road conditions.
