AREA AGENCY ON AGING

Offering Choices for Independent Lives

Community Information Specialists are trained to answer questions about our services and the array of community resources available, including help in resolving problems related to Medicare, Medicaid, and insurance. Caregiver library resources and educational opportunities are also available. AAA also takes referrals for MIChoice Medicaid Waiver in-home services, for which eligibility is required. There may be waiting lists so call as soon as needs are imminent. Care Management and in-home services are also available on a fee-for-service basis.

AAA has several volunteer programs designed to support seniors, grandparents raising grandchildren, and special needs children. Volunteers are always needed and they receive regular training and a stipend. Seniors may also qualify for receiving the services of a volunteer.

Seniors aged fifty-five and older with an income under 125% of Poverty can qualify for employment opportunities with non-profit organizations. Call Area Agency on Aging at **1-800-654-2810** for information.

If you need a ride for medical care or to the Civic Center for activities, call Covert Senior Lifeline at 764-8378 to be taken by a volunteer. Volunteer drivers are reimbursed through the Township Senior Millage so you must be 60 or over and a township resident. Other restrictions apply.

SENIOR MILLAGE HOME REPAIR AND CHORE SERVICES

Home Repair and Chore Services are available through Senior Services of Van Buren County with funding received from the Covert Township Senior Millage. Both services are available to residents age 60 and over who live in Covert Township.

Home Repairs

Qualifying residents can receive **one** home repair for no more than \$750 every other funding year (July thru June). The home repairs are considered permanent improvements to a home to prevent or remedy a sub-standard condition or safety hazard.

Chore Services

Qualifying residents can receive up to \$300 every funding year (July thru June) and can have multiple chores during the funding year but the total expended on all chores cannot exceed the \$300 maximum. Chore services are household maintenance tasks to increase the safety of the senior; usually one time in nature.

LEGAL SERVICES

Legal Aid of Western MI, partially funded by Area Agency on Aging, provides free legal advice and representation in a broad range of consumer cases, family matters, housing problems, government benefits such as SSI, Food Stamps and Medicaid, and other "non-fee-generating" cases. Eligibility for seniors is not based on income or assets, but rather is for anyone 60+.


